# THE PREVIOUSLY UNLISTED FORGERIES <br> NETHERLANDS ANTILLES (CURACAO) 

## 1929 Six Cents Surcharge

At the Musée de la Poste-Paris there are a matrix (negative) and two photoprints of this surcharge which was used 1 November 1929 on the $71 / 2$ cents orange red stamp of 1928 . Sperati has dated his matrix October 1949. Only the inverted variety would have been of sufficient value to attract Sperati's interest.

Specific Tests
(i) The top thin line has a weakness above the right thick bar. The top of this bar is concave over and to the right of its middle.
(ii) The SW quadrant of the loop of the " 6 " has three dots on its inside. The back of the " 6 " has an indentation about $40 \%$ of the way up from the bottom.
(iii) The lower arm of the "C" tapers down toward its end. The end of the top arm of this letter has an indentation.
