Sperati is known to have made "die" proofs in colour and probably made unused and used reproductions on genuine paper from which the impression of a genuine but common stamp had been successfully removed.

The genuine stamp and overprint were produced by typography and the reproductions were made by photo-lithography.

Basic tests: B, D, E and F.

SPECIFIC TESTS

- (i) The thick square in the upper right corner is broken at bottom.
- (ii) There is a dot in the "C" of "Fco"
- (iii) There is a break in the second frame line under the "PO" of "POSTALE."
- (iv) The thin square in the lower right corner is broken at bottom.
- (v) The "ESTERO" over print is heavier and by comparison the serifs are very much thicker than the genuine.
